Helpful Information to Help You Submit Great Images

The images you send through are a really important aspect of your acquittal. They provide strong support to your project and are a great visual review of what actually occurred.

Images are also an important support to Case Studies which help to promote the Regional Arts Fund, and assist us in advocating on behalf of artists, community groups and organisations for further opportunities and greater support.

All images submitted with your application must be in the following format;

- 300ppi (pixels per inch)
- 3.5 megabyte file size (or more, per image)
- Jpeg format

Basic tips to help take a good photo;

- Always have the sun/ light source behind you, the photographer. If you have it behind the subject the subject will come out as a dark mess!
- Think about how you want to frame your photo.
- When taking photos with your phone, always use the Landscape position and remember to touch the screen to focus.
